Soul Ties...pt. 8

Take Back the Power and Cut the Cord

- Acknowledge the Ungodly soul ties in your life
- Confess and repent of them
- Forgive those who bound you
- Break and separate from them (if directed by the Holy Spirit)

I.e... after divorce, or the end of a friendship, leaving a workplace or grieving the loss of a relationship

Prayer to Break Ungodly Soul Ties

Instructions:

Make sure you do this <u>ALL OUT LOUD!</u> Think of it as giving testimony in a court case. Testimony is always out loud.

The enemy is a legalist who has brought charges against you. He's the prosecutor, Jesus is your attorney, and the Father is the Judge. By confessing this out loud, you are taking back the ground he stole and grabbing hold of the what is already yours because of the death and resurrection of Jesus.

Now, let's get started!

Lord, I ask you to reveal to my mind right now the names of all the those that I have an ungodly soul tie with.

(Pause and listen)... when no more names come...

Lord, I confess that I have had unhealthy attachments to other people and relationships that are ungodly in nature. I now repent for violating Your boundaries in relationships. Thank you for your forgiveness and cleansing.

In the Name of Jesus Christ, I now renounce, break and loose myself from all
control enforced by the enemy in my relationships and any ungodly soul ties and
unhealthy bonding with the following people

Lord, I ask you to do whatever it takes to break me of my tendencies toward uncontrollable thoughts, domination, control, passivity, apathy, unforgiveness, anger, blame, accusations, fear, intimidation, and disobedience in relationships.

"Finally, in the name of Jesus Christ, I declare every hold of the enemy in my life that has come as a result of unhealthy soul ties, null and void. I renounce all unclean soul tie spirits and command you to depart from my spirit, soul, and body! In Jesus 'Name. Amen"

(Sometimes it is necessary to rid our homes of any objects connected to these people, for example jewelry or other gifts. Ask the Lord if that is needed)
